Sports First Team Teaching	£5495	Upskill teachers in a variety of sports disciplines	As a result of team teaching with a qualified sports coach, all teachers feel their confidence and competence has continued to increase. Children have received more individual support and attention as a result of having 2 qualified teachers in each lesson.
Subsidised after school sports club spaces	£3287	Aim to increase take up of after school sports clubs by reducing the cost to parents	The number of children attending after school sports clubs has increased from last year. Currently 61 after school club spaces are taken up each week, compared to 38 spaces per week at the same point in the academic year 2015-16. This is a significant increase.
Fully funded spaces in an after school sports club for all pupil premium children	£258	To ensure some of the most vulnerable children have access to sport, who might otherwise not have had the chance.	6 children were eligible for PP this year, of which 3 took up the funded space in an after school club. This represents a 50% take up which is significantly above the rate of take up of spaces when compared to all children.
