Physical Development

Practise writing your name, find creative ways to do it, writing on a misty window, chalk it outside then use a paintbrush to write it away! Check our class page if you are not sure of the correct letter formation. Don't forget to use a capital letter at the beginning of names and lower case letters for the rest!

Communication and Language

Talk to your family about any Nursery Rhymes. Find out their favourite Nursery rhyme and why. Can you change any rhymes and make them into your own rhymes? Make them as silly as you like! Think of words that start with the same letter as your name and other family names and make up silly sentences e.g. silly Simon squeaks sometimes.

Mathematics

Sing some counting songs. Can you count to 20 forwards and back. Count the stairs counting forwards as you go up and back as you go down. Can you carry on the count starting at different numbers? Counting backwards can be tricky so think carefully. Have a go at making some numbers with playdough; can you make them face the right way? Don't forget numbers 3 and 7 try to catch you out! Now try writing some numbers – are they all facing the right way?

Expressive Arts & Design

Try telling stories without books; you could even try making some puppets to tell your stories with. Sing songs from school to your family – they will think you sound great! Why not try some painting? Finger painting can be lots of fun if you don't have any paintbrushes.



Literacy

Practice your new phonemes every day; don't forget to use the actions because this will help you remember them. Go on a phoneme hunt in your books. How many 'a' can you find on a page? Look at as many books as you can. Can you read We're going on a Bear Hunt? The library will have a copy if you don't have it at home.

Understanding the World

Talk about the weather on the way to school each day, it's now Autumn and you will see lots of changes in the weather and even in the trees. Make an Autumn picture with things that you find on an Autumn walk.
